Download Economist.com in MP3 Format



Content

The audio edition contains word-for-word recordings of all articles published in The Economist. You can download the full edition or individual sections. You can also listen to select articles directly from your computer.

File Sizes/Download Time

Files are in MP3 format.

Each full edition is about 130 megabytes; individual sections/stories are about 10 megabytes each.

Subscribers with a broadband connection can expect to download a section in 3 minutes, and to download a full edition in 15 minutes.

How to Logon

Log on using the Business Library's [The Economist Audio Edition](#) database page. *NOTE that access requires a username and password; click on the "Get a Password" link to the left of the on/off campus log in link to locate these.*

From the [Economist.com home page](#), select Audio and Video>Audio Edition on the left frame. Click on the "Log in and Download Video Edition" button in the middle of the page.

You will be prompted to enter the email/password; you will be returned to the previous page once you login.

How to Download

Click on the "Download audio edition" button (to download the full print edition or a section name).

About mid-way down the page, you will see download options for:

--This week's edition

--Download sections

--Download past editions

Select "Save", and choose a destination folder on your computer. Downloaded audio files are in zipped MP3 format and will need to be extracted using WinZip before you can listen to them. If you want, you can then upload the audio files to a portable device for when you're on the move.

NOTE: Please be aware that some audio players have a "crossfade" function, which when activated can result in articles being cut short. To deactivate this setting on iTunes, go to Edit / Preferences, select the Playback tab, and uncheck Crossfade Playback.
