Search tips for creating company lists

The library subscribes to several resources for identifying lists of companies that will or will consider sponsoring international students.

Special directories

Locate firms with locations both in the US and abroad

- Directory of foreign firms operating in the United States
BUS REF HG4057.A21943
- Directory of American firms operating in foreign countries
BUS REF HG4538.A1 D5

Nexis.com

Identifies companies based on parent and subsidiary location; includes 182,000 companies, with 62,000 international parent companies. To search these, select:

- Find more sources > Directory of Corporate Affiliations
- Search: Parent (country) and United States
- for example: Parent (Spain) and United States

Hoover's

Includes over 16 million U.S. and international public and private companies. The company profiles include industry description, history, products and operations, subsidiaries, and competitors. To build a target list:

- Select Build Company Lists
- Select from a variety of criteria, including geography (metro area, area code, state, zip code, region); sales; number of employees; SIC code/industry description.

U.S. Department of Labor

The US Department of Labor tracks companies who have sponsored H1-B applications. You can search this data online via their H1-B Labor Certification Database at <http://www.flcdatacenter.com/CaseData.aspx>
