

## Locating Full Text of Journals, Papers and Books

### **Step 1: Ejournals <http://business.library.emory.edu/eresources/e-journals/ejournals.html>**

The General Libraries, Health Sciences Library and Emory's Oxford University Library have consolidated their efforts to produce a more comprehensive eJournals database that provides access to the full-text journals available to Emory University faculty, residents, staff and students. The [eJournals @ Emory University Libraries](#) database includes online, full text journals to which Emory's libraries have paid subscriptions, either directly through the publisher or through licensed databases and other resources to which Emory has access. The [eJournals @ Emory University Libraries](#) database is still evolving and does not yet represent a complete and comprehensive listing of such journals, but its coverage will expand rapidly over the coming year.
